

Statement of ICJM on the reception of CHARLES CARDINAL BO to the Myanmar junta CHIEF MIN AUNG HLAING on the occasion of Christmas visit

We, the Catholic population is trembled with rage, terribly upset and saddened upon the meeting of Charles Cardinal Bo with Myanmar junta chief Min Aung Hlaing on 23 December 2021.

This meeting do not represent the Catholic Church and population in Myanmar as that against the stand of all the Catholics in Myanmar. ICJM seriously condemns Charles Cardinal Bo and that of those who has acknowledge the Myanmar junta by any reason of general interests.

This meeting itself exposed the disregard and insult to the people of Myanmar who have suffered murder, lawless seizures, tourtures, and devastation of the Churches since in the beginning of the coup d'état.

As ICJM is the network standing for justice and peace, we absolutely oppose those who collaborate with the perpetrators and firmly stand with those who fight for justice and righteous.
